Methodology:

THIS POLL WAS CONDUCTED FROM SEPTEMBER 4-7, 2014, AMONG A NATIONAL SAMPLE OF 2252 REGISTERED VOTERS. THE INTERVIEWS WERE CONDUCTED ONLINE AND THE DATA WERE WEIGHTED TO APPROXIMATE A TARGET SAMPLE OF REGISTERED VOTERS BASED ON AGE, RACE/ETHNICITY, GENDER, EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, REGION, ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME, HOME OWNERSHIP STATUS AND MARITAL STATUS. RESULTS FROM THE FULL SURVEY HAVE A MARGIN OF ERROR OF PLUS OR MINUS 2.1 PERCENTAGE POINTS.
