- Three in 4 voters say federal government should take the lead role in rebuilding our nation's transportation infrastructure by directing federal funds and providing incentives for private business


Methodology:

Morning Consult, on behalf of U.S. Chamber of Commerce, conducted an online survey of 1,996 registered voters from May 04-06, 2017. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of +/- 2 percentage points.

Which is Why Strong Majorities Say Federal Government Should Invest More in All Aspects of Ground Transportation Infrastructure


Should the U.S. government invest more in each of the following aspects of the country's ground transportation infrastructure?





And Voters Want Congress to Pass a Transportation Infrastructure Package Now


Which of the following comes closest to your view, even if neither is exactly right?





Two in 3 Democrats and Republicans Say Congress Should Move Forward with an Infrastructure Package


Which of the following comes closest to your view, even if neither is exactly right?





Overwhelming Agreement the Federal Government Should Take the Lead Role in Rebuilding Infrastructure


Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: The federal government should take the lead role in rebuilding our nation's transportation infrastructure by directing federal funds and providing incentives for private business


