Crosstabulation Results

Methodology:

This poll was conducted from July 23-31, 2019, among a national sample of 2153 NFL Fans. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted to approximate a target sample of NFL Fans based on age, race/ethnicity, gender, educational attainment, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 2 percentage points.
